Liztex Guatemala at the location listed below hereby cites its objection to the above request certifying the ability to supply the Circular knit FLEECE under HTS 6001.21 in Cotton/Polyester in mélange or heather colorations in the quantities required.

Liztex can supply 4,536,000 kilograms or about 7,300,000 meters of Fleece under HTS Subheading 6001.21.

In fiber Content 80% Cotton 20% Polyester Three Thread Circular Knit Fleece

1) Face Yarn

100% Combed Cotton Ring Spun 49/1 to 54/1 metric

in each coloration

100% Bleached or dyed Cotton

95% Undyed/5% dyed Cotton

90% Undyed/10% Dyed Cotton

80% Undyed/20% Dyed Cotton

70% Undyed/30% Dyed Cotton

60% Undyed/40% Dyed Cotton

50% Undyed/50% Dyed Cotton

40% Undyed/60% Dyed Cotton

30% Undyed/70% Dyed Cotton

20% Undyed/80% Dyed Cotton

Above varying up to 2% percentage points.

2) Tie Yarn

183 – 188/48 Textured filament metric Polyester

3) Fleece Yarn

70% Carded Ring Spun of 70% Cotton 1.85 Denier Polyester Staple 26/1 –30/1 metric (15.5/1 –18/1)

1.85 denier is substitutable for 2.25 denier in our opinion

Liztex circular knitting machines are 20 and 18 gauge and completely substitutable for 21 gauge in making this product.

Liztex manufactures in weights 247 to 258 grams per square meter


Cutable width is 152 centimeters or 60" open width

Finish: Napped on technical back Liztex has up to date equipment to heavily nap this fabric, Bleached, Dyed, of Yarns of different colors.
Performance criteria: Liztex confirms not more than 5% vertical and horizontal shrinkage; and not more than 4% vertical torque.

It should also be noted that Guatemala is a short 2 hour 15 minute flight from Miami and delivery time from the Mill location in Guatemala to the Factory in El Salvador is less than 5 hours which is obviously advantageous over fabric sourced in Asia and should be of tremendous benefit to Intradeco's US Customer enhancing a much shorter lead-time and turn time to their benefit.

We have not been contacted by ST&R or Intradeco regarding this but would immediately supply counter samples if they could send a sample of their fabric to the Mill as follows:
