My name is Jeff Peck. I represent International Textile Group. We have six domestic textile plants located in the United States. We are a leading manufacturer of woven textiles. We are responding to a short supply request by School Apparel for a poly rayon acrylic blend fabric. Initially it was thought that the yarn for this fabric was not commercially available in the United States. It has come to our attention that National Spinning Company of Washington, NC is capable of making a yarn that would meet the specification supplied in the short supply request with capacity of approximately 20,000 pounds per week or one million pounds annually. 
We have a weaving facility in Cordova, NC (Rapier looms, perfect for such styling) and two finishing facilities, one in Raeford NC and one in Burlington NC. These facilities have the capacity (currently operate on a 4-5 day schedule, so we have a minimum of 500,000 yards of capacity for this type of fabric) to manufacture the needs of School Apparel. We have experience in making these types of poly rayon acrylic blend fabrics. Burlington has years of experience in processing these particular blends. We have not run these in over 10 years but we do have the equipment, expertise and knowledge in processing these fabrics.

We have reached out to School Apparel and they have sent physical samples for us to review. The fabrics look fairly straight forward. We have the finishing equipment that is described in the short supply request and have used it to finish similar products.
